USE OF THE TIMETABLE PAGES


FOR THE TIMETABLE PERIOD 2024-2025

In the timetable fields:

- **bold** station names indicate an interchange station. The numbers of the associated timetable fields are marked with **bold italic** numbers after the station name.
- The station names highlighted in grey mark the stops of the rail replacement buses ()
- The stations connected by brackets refer to trains running between these stations, the timetable of which can be found in the timetable field with the sequence number indicated after the brackets.
- The times of the trains (downward ↓ or upward ↑) are to be read according to the arrow.
- The train numbers shown in fractions in the header also indicate that the given train runs on certain sections of the route on different days or stops at certain stops only occasionally.
- The sign under the train number in the header (**from 91 to 99**) indicates that information about the train is included in the footnote below the timetable.
- The exemption from seat reservation for certain sections of the route indicated in the train's footnote (Ⓐ) does not apply to seats in the premium sections of the trains marked with the 21 sign in the header resp. to seats in first class on the trains marked with 1.

The trains:

- usually run with 2nd class carriages, a separate reference to this is not made. If there are 1st class carriages in the train, this is indicated with the number 1 under the train number.
- The header of the train indicates the connection symbol (**S50**) or, if the train does not have a connection symbol, the symbol of the train type (**Sr**).
- Trains that do not run every day or run only at certain times are marked with a wavy line in front of the time indication. The operating period is indicated in front of the time indication and in the header of the train by symbols referring to its operation. In the case of end-of-year restrictions (**from 90 to 99**) there is no separate wavy line in front of the time indication.
- Trains with the pictogram ⓧ in front of their time indication only stop at the stops indicated if passengers wish to (dis)embark. We therefore ask you to press the stop request button in good time resp. to choose a place on the platform which is clearly visible to the train driver, if you wish to (dis)embark the train.

The timetable of rail replacement buses () is marked by the time indication highlighted in grey. The train tickets are valid for these buses, but adjacent seats and the transport of bicycles cannot be guaranteed.

The continuation of a direct train and trains carrying direct carriages are marked in the timetable with the symbol ()

Information about the detailed timetables of international trains can be found in the electronic timetables. In case of the operating periods, the months are indicated with Roman numerals and the days with Arabic numerals. (e.g.: from 1.VI. - 10.IX means that the train only runs from 1 June to 10 September, i.e. from 00:00 on 1 June to 23:59 on 10 September)
